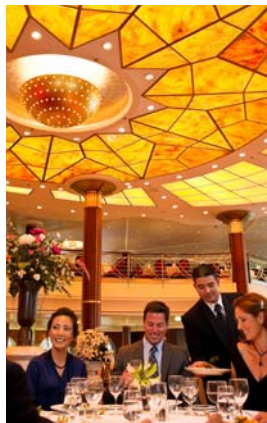
Key West, Florida
